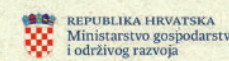
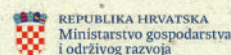

HOW?

- 1 Buy products that last longer and use less energy
- 2 Repair clothes, furniture and appliances
- 3 Reuse jars, boxes and cloth bags
- 4 Separate and recycle plastic, paper, metal and biowaste
- 5 Reduce the purchase of plastic by reusing bottles, bags and boxes
- 6 Use digital documents instead of paper
- 7 Share or donate what you don't need
- 8 Compost biowaste, create natural fertilizer

Waste separation: Instructions for proper sorting of household waste

Proper waste separation at home is essential for its reuse and recycling. With proper sorting we reduce the amount of waste going to landfills, save resources and help create new jobs.



RULES OF THUMB FOR RECYCLING PREPARATION

- Rinse the packaging, remove food and drink residues
- Separate and sort lids, clips, and other accessories
- Fold the packaging to take up less space
- Dispose of greasy and heavily soiled packaging in mixed waste
- Take complicated, bulky, and hazardous waste to a recycling center

The role of recycling centers

You can drop off waste that does not belong in household containers at recycling centers for free. There, the waste is properly sorted, temporarily stored, and prepared for recycling – in a way that protects the environment and our health.



HOW TO USE THE RECYCLING YARD CORRECTLY

- 1 Check which waste type is acceptable
- 2 Sort the waste at home
- 3 Visit during business hours
- 4 Respect quantity restrictions
- 5 Use designated containers
- 6 If unsure, ask staff
- 7 Do not leave waste outside the center
